

# POWER PINES CAMPGROUND RULES

*(Camp Host has the final decision on all matters).*

**1** SMUD employee/spouse or retiree must be present at time of check in. Children or guests of employees/retirees are not permitted to use Power Pines without the employee's/retirees presence.

**2** Each camper shall respect the space and privacy of others at all times.

**3** All motor vehicles must be operated at their quietest speed, to and from your campsite. All motor vehicles shall stay on designated roads.



**4** Campground speed limits of 5 MPH must be observed. Circulating around on campground roads is to be avoided.

**5** "Quad runners", motorcycles, or similar vehicles are to be used outside the campground. These vehicles must be idled out of and into the campground.

**6** Keep all vehicles off of the Campground fire trails, away from the penstock, powerhouse/switch yard and out the area south of the campground. No more than **three** vehicles shall be permitted in any one camp site. Vehicles include: boat trailers, utility trailers, RV's, trucks and cars.

**7** The use of outside electronic equipment, including electrical speakers, radios, televisions, or other machinery, shall be operated at a volume that is not offensive to other campers in adjacent campsites. **Quiet time is 10:00 pm through 7:00 am.**



**8** Firearms, airguns, or archery equipment are not allowed to be used in or around the campground.

**9** All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times (maximum length of 6 feet). You must have proof of your dog's rabies inoculation. Noisy or vicious dogs will be expelled from the campground. **Please** keep your dog(s) under control!!! Pets must accompany their owners when away from the campsite. No more than **TWO** dogs will be allowed in any one campsite.

**10** Parents are responsible for their children's actions in the campground. Instruct your children not to play in and around the restrooms.

**11** For safety reasons do not use the playground after dusk.

**12** Keep fires small and in the fire pit. Keep an area 10-feet in diameter cleared of burnable materials around fire pit. Ask Camp Host for tools. Stack firewood at least 10 feet from fire pit.

**13** Storing camp equipment, including trailers, campers, boats, vehicles or tents is allowed at the entrance to the campground. Prior to leaving any equipment/vehicle in the storage area, the camp Host **MUST** be notified and contact information provided. Information tags must be affixed to vehicle/equipment. Camp host will provide tags and sign up sheet. The long term storage of RV's and other vehicles is subject to the approval of the camp host. RV/vehicle overflow parking is not intended for long term storage.

**15** Remove all trash from campsite. Please use trash bins provided outside of Campground. Leave your campsite in better condition than you found it.
